

Draper Suncrest Stake Trek Emergency Action Plan – Martin’s Cove, WY

Emergency Coordination (Site Missionaries)

Site missionaries serve as the first line of assistance for all situations during trek. All medical needs, safety concerns, and emergency situations should be coordinated through them whenever possible. A senior missionary couple will be assigned to trek directly with the group, and additional missionaries will provide support as needed to ensure adequate coverage and redundancy. Leaders should communicate clearly with missionaries and rely on their direction in coordinating any response.

Medical Release Form

Each participant is required to have a completed medical release form prior to trek. This form includes emergency contact information, medical history, allergies, medications, and insurance details. Any special medical concerns, limitations, or instructions should be clearly documented on the form. Trek leadership and designated medical staff will reference this form in any medical situation, and all information will be kept confidential and only shared as necessary to provide appropriate care.

General Procedures

- Notify leader immediately
- Call 911 if serious • Coordinate through missionaries when possible
- Provide exact location and landmarks • Assign adult to meet responders

Medical Emergencies

- Give first aid; check medical form • Do not move unless necessary • Keep patient calm, shaded, hydrated

Lost or Missing Person

- Stop group movement, headcount • Identify last known location • Send two adults to search briefly • Call 911 if not found within 30 minutes

Wildfire Safety

- Follow fire restrictions • Keep fires controlled with water/shovel • Evacuate upwind/uphill if needed

Severe Weather

- Lightning: move to low ground • Wind/dust: shelter in place • Flood risk: move to higher ground

Communication & Accountability

- Assign leaders and rally points • Maintain buddy system • Frequent headcounts
